Tour of the William H. Wessels Collection

Collection located on Harrisburg Pike in Dillsburg, PA

Description: The William H. Wessels collection consists primarily of Full Classic senior-model Cadillacs, with one-offs such as a 1941 Derham-bodied Landulette. The collection concentrates on large, formal models, and, although many are Classics, there are several Cadillac Fleetwood limousines from the 50s and 60s. Other marques, such as Packard and Lincoln, are represented in the collection.

Logistics: You may tour on your own, or go with the group. If the latter, meet the Tour Director at the rear hotel portico at 1:30 pm.

Route: Drive approximately 22 miles north on Rt. 15 to Dillsburg. In Dillsburg, stay on Rt. 15 north, passing Baker's Diner on the left. After you go through the signaled intersection with Rt. 74, again stay on Rt. 15 and as you pass between the Wessels dealerships on the left and right sides of the road, begin watching for and turn sharp right on Harrisburg Pike about ½ mile beyond the Rt. 74 intersection. Proceed up the hill on Harrisburg Pike a short distance to the collection on the right. Further information about the route will be available from the Tour Director on the day of the event. It is strongly suggested that you review the route online using Google Maps or equivalent before you leave on the Tour.

Gasoline: It is suggested that you buy gas before the Tour at one of the several gas stations in and around Gettysburg, including a Sheetz a short distance from the Hotel west on Rt. 30. Otherwise, there are many stations along the way and in Dillsburg, PA.

Parking: Parking is available at the collection. There may be additional parking available nearby if needed.

Food: our hosts have graciously agreed to provide sandwiches and drinks at the Collection.
