Hello Everybody,

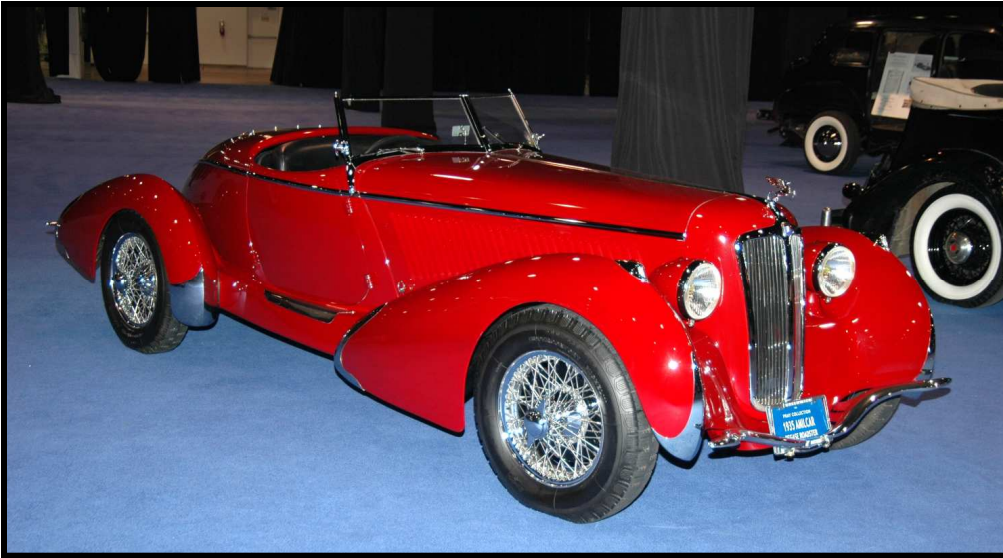
